TITLE:	<i>Artists of the American West, 1830-1930</i>
DESCRIPTION:	<p>This profusely illustrated survey course will investigate chronologically the Euro-American artists who depicted the Trans-Mississippi West frontier, and how their works interpreted and critiqued the westward expansion of Euro-American culture. How Montana and Northern Rocky Mountain artists depicted Native American culture will be emphasized. By focusing upon the lives and artworks of representative artists, the following topics will be analyzed: (1) art serving science; (2) art capturing the “disappearing” Indian; (3) art delineating the irresistible tide of white settlement, with its attendant and inescapable conflict of civilization versus wildness; (4) art celebrating the West’s grand landscapes and native fauna; (5) art promoting tourism; and, finally (6) art as a medium for mythologizing the West’s iconic period in American history. Numerous books on these topics will be available for study, and vintage 19th century prints by notable artists from the instructor’s collection will be shown. The class will conclude with a visit to the CM Russell Museum. Art and history of the American West will be intimately interwoven.</p>
